

Vehicle registration, driver license waivers to end April 14, 2021

The temporary driver licenses and vehicle titles and registrations waivers, allowing residents to put off renewing their due to the COVID-10 pandemic, will end on **April 14, 2021**.

Vehicle title and registration renewal

*Online renewal is available up to nine months past your registration expiration date. *

Mail:

Send the following:

- renewal notice received in the mail (keep the vehicle owner's section for your records)
- photocopy of your vehicle insurance card
- registration fee
- copy of current inspection report

In-Person:

Bring your registration renewal notice, proof of current liability insurance and current inspection report to your county tax assessor-collector.

Mail:

If you received an invitation to renew by mail, you can also choose to renew [online](#) or by phone. To renew by mail, please follow all the instructions on the form.

In-Person *BY APPOINTMENT ONLY*:

To schedule an appointment or check availability, visit the [online appointment scheduler](#).

If your driver license has expired, and your scheduled appointment is on or after April 15, 2021, you may request a temporary license to operate a motor vehicle until your appointment date. In order for your request to be processed, your request will need to be submitted through the [DPS Contact page](#).*

When submitting your request, please complete all of the requested fields and include the following information in the Questions section of the form:

- *Date of your appointment*
- *State that you are requesting a Temporary License (requests that do not reference this will not be processed)*

**If you have an appointment scheduled on or before April 14, 2021 you are not eligible to obtain a temporary license. **
